

## EHL APPLICATION-SELECTION 2025

ENPP, together with its members and other partners in several European countries, is preparing a new application for the European Heritage Label, in the transnational site application format.

This joint application of sites in Europe where Peace Treaties were signed, will highlight the European character of one of the most important symbols of the European Union - Peace and, on the other hand, will allow you to value the common elements of Europe's History and Intangible Heritage .

The joint application of European sites located in various countries will give them a cultural and architectural diverse dimension, and reinforces mutual understanding and intercultural dialogue in the European Union.

This joint application will contribute significantly to a greater European visibility of the sites in Europe where Peace Treaties were signed, it will allow greater common knowledge and awareness of the importance of the Peace Treaties for the History and for the political, social and economic development of the European people, through carrying out joint actions whose impact is far greater than that of individual isolated applications from the sites that comprise it.
